ORDINANCE NO. 5491

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of a grant award with the U.S. Department of Justice Office of Community Oriented Policing Services to accept grant funds from the Homeland Security Overtime Program; establishing a project within the Operating Grants and Donations Fund by appropriating unanticipated and future revenues to that fund; and authorizing expenditures of said grant funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute that certain grant award with the U.S. Department of Justice Office of Community Oriented Policing Services, a copy of which contract is hereby given Clerk's Receiving No. 34691.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said contract.

Section 3. At the time of execution of said contract and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within the Operating Grants and Donations Fund into which all said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have the authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance is:

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Section 6. Upon execution of said contract and acceptance of said funding, the budget for the Operating Grants and Donations Fund shall be amended by appropriating to that fund anticipated revenue in excess of estimated revenue in the amount of the grant proposal and acceptance herein authorized to the Operating Grants and Donations Fund, currently anticipated in the following amount:

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said grant contract should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. The Finance Director or his designee is authorized to make interfund loans from the appropriate city fund to the Operating Grants and Donations Fund in whatever amounts for whatever duration or under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in the Operating Grants and Donations Fund that may be created by this grant.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.


