ORDINANCE NO. 5514

AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance No. 5512 by authorizing the use of grant funds to increase a 0.56 FTE position in the Fire Department's Emergency Preparedness Division to a 0.715 position.

WHEREAS, on February 17, 2004 the Bellevue City Council passed Ordinance No. 5512 authorizing execution of an agreement bearing Clerk's Receiving No. 35293 with the Washington State Military Department to accept grant funds for emergency management purposes; and

WHEREAS, the grant funding was proposed to increase a 0.56 FTE Office Assistant Position in the Fire Department's Emergency Preparedness Division to a 0.715 FTE position; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 5512 which authorized execution of an agreement bearing Clerk's Receiving No. 35293 with the Washington State Military Department to except grant funds for emergency management purposes is hereby amended to allow said grant funds to increase a 0.56 FTE Office Assistant Position in the Fire Department's Emergency Preparedness Division to a 0.715 FTE position, provided that any future change in the amount of the grant will lead to a corresponding change in the FTE position.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.
