## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

### ORDINANCE NO. 5539

AN ORDINANCE amending the 2003-2009 CIP to increase the appropriation to the General CIP Fund and to increase the Transportation Demand Management (CIP Plan No. PW-R-87) budget in the amount of \$70,049 and authorizing the City Manager or his designee to: 1) execute a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) for acceptance of a Commute Trip Reduction (CTR) Performance Grant award in support of a new Bellevue FlexPass Distribution Incentive Program; and 2) enter into an agreement with King County Department of Transportation to share responsibilities for the administration of the Bellevue FlexPass Distribution Incentive Program and to accept Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) grant funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City's 2003-2009 General Capital Investment Program Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 5426 on December 9, 2002 as previously amended is hereby further amended by increasing the appropriation to said CIP fund and to increase the project budget for CIP Plan No. PW-R-87, Transportation Demand Management by \$70,049 reflecting grant awards from the Washington State Department of Transportation and King County. Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified in said grant agreements shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) for acceptance of a Commute Trip Reduction (CTR) Performance Grant award in support of a new Bellevue FlexPass Distribution Incentive Program; a copy of which Contract is hereby given Clerk's Receiving No. 36280.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an agreement with King County Department of Transportation to share responsibilities for the administration of the Bellevue FlexPass Distribution Incentive Program and to accept Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) grant funds, a copy of which Contract is hereby given Clerk's Receiving No. 36281.

# ORIGINAL

Section 4. The City Manager or his designee shall have the responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.
