ORDINANCE NO. 5547

AN ORDINANCE amending the 2003-2009 Capital Investment Program Plan (CIP) to increase the appropriation to the General CIP Fund and to increase the Minor Capital Traffic Operations program (CIP Plan No. PW-M-2) budget in the amount of \$416,527; authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with King County for acceptance of \$416,527 in federal funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City's 2003-2009 General Capital Investment Program Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 5426 on December 9, 2002 as previously amended is hereby further amended by increasing the appropriation to said CIP fund and to increase the Minor Capital Traffic Operations Program budget for CIP Plan No. PW-M-2, by \$416,527 reflecting a grant award from King County. Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said grant agreement shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with King County for acceptance of \$416,527 in federal Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) II funds for implementation of the Video Surveillance Support and Coordination Project; a copy of which Contract is hereby given Clerk's Receiving No. 36582

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have the responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.
