ORDINANCE NO. 5590

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute an agreement with the Washington State Criminal Justice Training Commission (WSCJTC) to provide staffing and accept funding for staffing; amending the 2005-2006 General Fund budget and appropriation to increase by \$155,172 and adding an additional FTE that will be paid from the funds from the WSCJTC

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an agreement with the WSCJTC to accept funding for reimbursement for the City paying the full salary and benefits of a corporal from 2005 – 2007 while he/she is an academy instructor. A copy of this Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 37272.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Agreement.

Section 3. The approximate amount for 2005-2006 and source of revenue for these funds are:

WSCJTC	\$155,172.00

For 2007, the amount received from WSCJTC will be based on the existing salary and benefits of a corporal for that year.

Section 4. Upon execution of said Agreement, the 2005-2006 General Fund budget, adopted pursuant to Ordinance No. 5580, is hereby amended by increasing the budget of said Fund by \$155,172.00 to reflect additional revenues in the amount of the funding and acceptance herein authorized.

Section 5. The 2005-2006 General Fund appropriation, adopted pursuant to Ordinance No. 5580, is hereby amended by increasing the appropriation to said Fund by \$155,172.00.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said Agreement should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the budget and appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 6. The Police Department shall have one additional FTE for the period that the corporal is on loan to the WSCJTC funded fully with WSCJTC funds. Said FTE shall be eliminated upon the termination of this Agreement.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.




