

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5606

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute an Interlocal Agreement to provide Public Safety Wireless Mobile Communication Services to the City of Mercer Island; amending the 2005-2006 General CIP Fund appropriation by \$34,188 and amending the 2005-2011 CIP Plan, to increase the project budget for CIP Plan No. PS-58, Zone 1 Wireless by \$34,188.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement to provide Public Safety Wireless Mobile Communication Services to the City of Mercer Island, a copy of which Interlocal Agreement is hereby given Clerk's Receiving No. 37926.

Section 2. The City's 2005-2006 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund appropriation adopted by Ordinance No. 5580 on December 6, 2004, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said CIP Fund by \$34,188.

Section 3. The City's 2005-2011 General CIP Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 5580 on December 6, 2004 as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the project budget for CIP Plan No. PS-58, Zone 1 Wireless by \$34,188.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified herein shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the 2005-2006 General CIP Fund appropriation and 2005-2011 CIP Plan shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designee shall have the responsibility for the administration and expenditure of said funds and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. The Finance Director or her designee is authorized to make interfund loans from an appropriate City fund to the General CIP Fund in whatever amounts, for whatever duration or under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in the General CIP Fund that may be created by this agreement.

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Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.




