ORDINANCE NO. 5621

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City Manager to execute an Interlocal Agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to receive 2005-2007 state technical assistance funds to support the City's Commute Trip Reduction Program; to execute an Interlocal Agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the King County Department of Transportation for Commute Trip Reduction implementation services; and to amend the 2005-2006 Operating Grants and Donations Fund by increasing the appropriation by \$194,002.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to receive 2005-2007 state technical assistance funds, in the amount of \$194,002, to support the City's Commute Trip Reduction Program and to execute an Interlocal Agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the King County Department of Transportation for Commute Trip Reduction implementation services, in the amount of \$112,002, copies of these Interlocal Agreements have been given Clerk's Receiving Nos. 38248 and 38321.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Interlocal Agreements.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into Agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the WSDOT Interlocal Agreement and acceptance are:

Section 5. Upon execution of said Interlocal Agreement the City's 2005-2006 Operating Grants and Donations Fund adopted by Ordinance 5580 on December 6, 2004, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said Fund by \$194,002.
