CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5630

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City Manager, or his designee, to execute a non-professional services contract between the City of Bellevue and Mini-Mountain Sports Centre, Ltd. for the operation and management of programs at the indoor Climbing Wall at South Bellevue Community Center; and amending the 2005-2006 General Fund budget by \$90,000 to reflect the increased revenue and expense associated with this program.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a non-professional services contract between the City of Bellevue and Mini-Mountain Sports Centre, Ltd. for the operation and management of programs at the indoor Climbing Wall at South Bellevue Community Center. A copy of this Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 38322.

Section 2. The 2005-2006 General Fund appropriation, adopted by Ordinance No. 5580 on December 6, 2004, as previously amended, is hereby further amended by \$90,000 to reflect the increased revenues and expenses associated with this program.

Section 3. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Agreement.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said monies and shall have all the authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.
