

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5639

AN ORDINANCE amending the 2005-2006 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund by increasing the Fund appropriation by \$2,085,000 to reflect the unanticipated revenues from King County Conservation Futures of \$1,885,000 and Bellevue Botanical Garden Society's Donation of \$200,000, and amending the 2005-2011 CIP Plan by increasing the project budget for CIP Plan No. P-AD-15, Property Acquisition, to reflect the unanticipated revenues from King County Conservation Futures of \$1,885,000 and Bellevue Botanical Garden Society's Donation of \$200,000.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City's 2005-2006 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund appropriation adopted by Ordinance No. 5580 on December 6, 2004, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said CIP Fund by \$2,085,000.

Section 2. The City's 2005-2011 General CIP Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 5580 on December 6, 2004, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the project budget for CIP Plan No. P-AD-15, Property Acquisition, by \$2,085,000.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have the responsibility for the administration of said monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. The Finance Director or his or her designee is authorized to make interfund loans from an appropriate City fund to the CIP Fund in whatever amounts, for whatever duration, and under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in said funds that may be created by this purchase.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.
