

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5659

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of an Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) 2004 Homeland Security Grant agreement with King County (and necessary supplements) to accept \$121,911.00 in grant reimbursement funds for the purchase of personal protective hazardous materials and rescue equipment; establishing a project within the Operating Grants and Donation Fund; appropriating additional revenues to the Operating Grants and Donations Fund; authorizing expenditures of said grant funds and appropriating unanticipated and future revenues to that fund and authorizing interfund loans.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) 2004 Homeland Security Grant agreement with King County (and necessary supplements) to accept \$121,911.00 in grant reimbursement funds for the purchase of personal protective hazardous materials and rescue equipment. A copy of said Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 39163.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Agreement.

Section 3. At the time of acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within the Operating Grants and Donations Fund into which all said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for this grant proposal and acceptance are:

King County	\$121,911.00
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Section 6. Upon acceptance of the grant funds, the budget for the Operating Grants and Donations Fund shall be amended by appropriating revenues in the amount of the grant and acceptance herein authorized.

<u>Description</u>	<u>Amount Appropriated</u>
Operating Grants and Donations Fund	\$121,911.00

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said Agreement should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the budget and appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. The Finance Director or her designee is authorized to make interfund loans from the appropriate City fund to the Operating Grants and Donations Fund in whatever amounts for whatever duration or under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in the Operating Grants and Donations Fund that may be created by this grant.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.




