ORDINANCE NO. 5660

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the execution of two Energy Conservation Grant agreements (and supplements if necessary) with Puget Sound Energy to accept grant funds resulting from energy modeling of the New City Hall (NCH).

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute two Energy Conservation Grant agreements (and supplements if necessary) with Puget Sound Energy to accept in total \$169,356.00 in grant funds (\$153,716 for the entire building/systems and \$15,640 for parking garage ventilation equipment/systems). A copy of said Agreements respectively are hereby given Clerk's Receiving Nos. 39370 and 39371.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Agreements.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for these grant proposals and acceptance are:

Section 5. The Finance Director or her designee is authorized to make interfund loans from the appropriate City fund to the General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund in whatever amounts for whatever duration or under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in the CIP Fund that may be created by this grant.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.




