

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5700

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute Amendment No. 1 to the Interlocal Agreement (and any necessary supplements) with the State of Washington, Department of Ecology to accept \$39,288.00 in grant funds to implement an additional waste prevention project; depositing funds into the Bellevue Commercial Pollution Prevention Research Project within the Grants and Donation Fund, and appropriating unanticipated and future revenues to those funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute Amendment No. 1 to the Interlocal Agreement (and any necessary supplements) with the State of Washington, Department of Ecology to accept \$39,288.00 in grant funds to implement an additional waste prevention project, a copy of which Amendment No. 1 to the Interlocal Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 40800.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Amendment.

Section 3. At the time of acceptance, said grant funds shall be deposited into the existing Bellevue Commercial Pollution Commercial Prevention Research Project established within the Operating Grants and Donation Fund.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for this grant proposal and acceptance are:

Section 6. Upon acceptance of the grant funds, the budget for Operating Grants and Donations Fund shall be amended by appropriating revenues in the amount of the grant and acceptance herein authorized.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said Amendment No. 1 to the Interlocal Agreement should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the budget and appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.


