ORDINANCE NO. 5740

AN ORDINANCE authorizing amending the Interlocal Agreement governing the allocation of additional funds made available from the King County Conservation Futures Fund, amending the 2007-2008 General CIP Fund appropriation by \$750,000, and amending the 2007-2013 CIP Plan to increase the project budget for CIP Plan No. P-AD-15 by \$750,000 to reflect unanticipated revenue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an amendment to the Interlocal Agreement previously given Clerk's Receiving No. 15972 (and any necessary supplements) governing the allocation of additional funds made available from the King County Conservation Futures Fund, a copy of which amendment is given Clerk's Receiving No. _____.

Section 2. The City's 2007-2008 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund appropriation adopted by Ordinance No. 5711 on December 11, 2006 as previously amended is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said CIP Fund by \$750,000.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified herein shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.


Section 3. The City's 2007-2013 General CIP Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 5711 on December 11, 2006 as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the project budget for CIP Plan No. P-AD-15 Property Acquisition by \$750,000.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designee shall have the responsibility for the administration and expenditure of said funds and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.




