

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5751

AN ORDINANCE repealing Chapter 3.50 of the Bellevue City Code relating to the Building Code Board of Appeals, and establishing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue desires to repeal Chapter 3.50 and otherwise absolve the Building Code Board of Appeals of jurisdiction over appeals of technical code interpretations by the Building Official; and

WHEREAS, by repealing Chapter 3.50, the City of Bellevue seeks to provide consistency in appellate proceedings among the City's construction codes and to provide efficiency in responding to such appeals; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue intends to use the Hearing Examiner to hear and make rulings relating to Construction Code appeals and interpretations where such appeals are authorized by the construction codes; now, therefore:

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 3.50 of the Bellevue City Code is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.




