

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5753

AN ORDINANCE 1) amending the 2007-2013 Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan to increase funding by \$14,000,000 by creating three new CIP projects and amending the project descriptions and budgets for three existing projects; 2) amending the 2007-2008 General CIP Fund to increase the appropriation by \$9,777,000; and 3) amending the 2007-2008 General Fund to increase the appropriation by \$304,000.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City's 2007-2013 Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 5711 on December 11, 2006, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase funding by \$14,000,000 by creating three new CIP projects and amending the project descriptions and budgets for three existing projects. The increased funding is hereby allocated as follows:






