ORDINANCE NO. 5763

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute three project agreements totaling \$1.3 million with the State of Washington's Recreation Conservation Office (RCO) for the Highland Skatepark construction, Meydenbauer (Yiu property) acquisition and Wilburton (Koh property) acquisition; and amending the 2007-2008 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund appropriation to increase by \$1,100,000; and amending the 2007-2013 CIP plan to increase CIP project P-AD-57 by \$100,000 and P-AD-15 by \$1,000,000.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to execute three project agreements totaling \$1.3 million with the State of Washington Recreation Conservation Office (RCO) for the Highland Skatepark construction (\$300,000 grant agreement) , Meydenbauer (Yiu property) acquisition (\$500,000 grant agreement) and Wilburton (Koh property) acquisition (\$500,000 grant agreement), copies of which agreements have been given Clerk's Receiving Nos. 41672 , 41786 , and 41785 .

Section 2. The City's 2007-2008 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund appropriation adopted by Ordinance No. 5711 on December 11, 2006 as previously amended is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said CIP Fund by \$1,100,000 to recognize funding from the following:

State RCO grant – Skatepark	\$ 300,000
Skatepark grant anticipated and budgeted	(200,000)
State RCO grant – Meydenbauer acquisition	500,000
State RCO grant – Wilburton acquisition	<u>500,000</u>
Total Unanticipated Funding	<u>\$1,100,000</u>

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified herein shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 3. The City's 2007-2013 General CIP plan adopted by Ordinance No. 5711 on December 11, 2006 as previously amended is hereby further amended to

increase the project budget for CIP P-AD-57 by \$100,000, and increase the project budget for P-AD-15 by \$1,000,000.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designee shall have the responsibility for the administration and expenditure of said funds and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.




