

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5776

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of an amendment to an agreement with the Washington State Criminal Justice Training Commission (WSCJTC) extending the term of the agreement to provide staffing to the WSCJTC and accepting funding for staffing; amending the 2008 General Fund budget and appropriation to increase by \$92,849 and authorizing an additional FTE that will be paid from the funds from the WSCJTC.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an amendment to an agreement (previously given Clerk's Receiving No. 37272) with the WSCJTC in the estimated amount of \$111,881 to provide a police corporal to the WSCJTC to be an instructor from March 2008 to February 2009 and to accept reimbursement for the full salary and benefits of the instructor for this period. A copy of this Amendment has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 41838.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Amendment.

Section 3. The approximate amount for 2008 and source of revenue for this proposal and acceptance are:

WSCJTC - 2008	\$92,849

For 2008, the amount received from WSCJTC will be based on the existing salary and benefits of a corporal for that year.

Section 4. Upon execution of said Amendment, the 2008 General Fund budget and appropriation, adopted pursuant to Ordinance No. 5711 on December 11, 2006 as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the budget and appropriation to said Fund by \$92,849.00 to reflect additional revenues in the amount of the funding and acceptance herein authorized.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said Amendment should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the budget and appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 5. The Police Department shall have one additional FTE for the period that the corporal is on loan to the WSCJTC funded fully with WSCJTC funds. Said FTE shall be eliminated upon the termination of the Agreement as extended by the Amendment.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.




