

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5782

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of an amendment to a grant agreement previously given Clerk's Receiving No. 41161 (and any necessary supplements) with the Washington State Military Department to accept additional grant funds in the amount of \$20,313 for emergency management purposes; extending the termination date of the grant agreement to December 31, 2008; appropriating the grant funds and unanticipated and future revenues to the project in the grants and donations fund established previously for the grant agreement; and authorizing expenditures of said grant funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an amendment to a grant agreement previously given Clerk's Receiving No. 41161 (and any necessary supplements) with the Washington State Military Department to accept additional grant funds in the amount of \$20,313 for emergency management purposes and extending the termination date of the grant agreement to December 31, 2008; a copy of which Amendment has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 44403.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Amendment.

Section 3. At the time of execution of said Amendment and acceptance of said funds, all said monies shall be deposited into the projects previously established within the Operating Grants and Donations Fund for the grant agreement given Clerk's Receiving No. 41161.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof including purchase agreements to expend funds as provided in said Amendment.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance is:

Department of Homeland Security (DHS)	
Washington State Military Department	\$20,313

Section 6. Upon execution of said Amendment, the budget for the Operating Grants and Donations Fund shall be amended by appropriating revenues in the amount of the grant and acceptance herein authorized.

<u>Description</u>	<u>Amount Appropriated</u>
Operating Grants and Donations Fund	\$20,313

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said Amendment should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.


