ORDINANCE NO. 5807

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City Manager or his designee to 1) amend the 2007-2013 Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan, adopted by Ordinance No. 5711, by creating a new project CIP No. G-70, Enterprise Maintenance Management; 2) amend the 2007-2008 General CIP to increase appropriations by \$953,000 to reflect the new project CIP; 3) execute a professional services agreement with Interloc Solutions for application development services on the Enterprise Maintenance Management Project, in an amount not to exceed \$949,400, plus any applicable taxes; and to execute a professional services agreement with Kathi Buchanan for project management and design services on the Enterprise Maintenance Management Project, in an amount not to exceed \$150,000 plus any applicable taxes.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new project, CIP Plan No. G-70, Enterprise Maintenance Management, is hereby created and added to the 2007-2013 CIP Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 5711.

Section 2. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to amend the City's 2007-2013 Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan, adopted by Ordinance No. 5711 on December 11, 2006 as previously amended, by increasing appropriations by \$953,000 to reflect the new project CIP.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to execute a professional services agreement with Interloc Solutions for application development services on the Enterprise Maintenance Management Project, in an amount not to exceed \$949,400, plus any applicable taxes.


Section 4. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to execute a professional services agreement with Kathi Buchanan for project management and design services on the Enterprise Maintenance Management Project, in an amount not to exceed \$150,000, plus any applicable taxes.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after passage and legal publication.


