ORDINANCE NO. 5812

AN ORDINANCE authorizing 1) execution of a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Transportation Improvement Board to accept \$200,000 in state funding awarded through the Urban Sidewalk Program; 2) amendment of the 2007-2008 General CIP fund to increase appropriation by \$200,000 in grant funds; 3) amendment of the 2007-2008 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan to increase the project budget for the NE 8th /Lake Washington Boulevard to 96th Ave NE Project (CIP Plan No. PW-WB-73); and 4) execution of a Professional Services Agreement with Perteet, Inc for engineering and design services, in an amount not to exceed \$338,528.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Transportation Improvement Board to accept \$200,000 in state funding awarded through the Urban Sidewalk Program, a copy of which agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 47957

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 3. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance are:

Section 4. Upon execution of said grant agreement, the City's 2007-2008 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund appropriation adopted by Ordinance No. 5711 on December 11, 2006, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said CIP as follows:

<u>Description</u>	<u>Amount Appropriated</u>
General CIP Fund	\$200,00

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Provided, however if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said grant agreement should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.


Section 5. Upon execution of said grant agreement, the City's 2007-2008 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund adopted by Ordinance No. 5711 on December 11, 2006, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the project budget for the NE 8th /Lake Washington Boulevard to 96th Ave NE Project (CIP Plan No. PW-WB-73) by \$200,000 to reflect the grant award.

Section 6. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a Professional Services Agreement with Perteet, Inc. for engineering and design services, in an amount not to exceed \$338,528 a copy of which agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 42704

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.


