

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5829

AN ORDINANCE related to Residential Permit Parking repealing Ordinances 3960 and 5409, and creating a new Residential Permit Parking Zone 4, restricting parking on streets within the zone to "No Parking 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Except Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays, Except by Zone 4 Permit".

WHEREAS, Policy TR-119 of the Transportation Element of the Comprehensive Plan states that the City will minimize spillover parking from commercial areas, parks, and other facilities encroaching on residential neighborhoods through residential parking zones; and

WHEREAS, over the past 20 years the City has been working with residents living in the Bellwood neighborhood to address spillover parking of vehicles from adjacent downtown businesses; and

WHEREAS, Council adopted Ordinances 3960 and 5409 to address the residential parking issue; and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure uniform enforcement of the zone restrictions and conserve Police resources, Zone 4 restrictions will be extended and changed; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinances 3960 and 5409 are hereby repealed.

Section 2. A new Residential Permit Parking – Zone 4 is hereby created for the following streets:

NE 13th Street, west of 108th Avenue NE
106th Place NE, south of NE 13th Street
The west side of 108th Avenue NE in front of residences 1233 and 1221
NE 14th Street, between 108th Avenue NE and 106th Avenue NE
NE 15th Street, between 106th Avenue NE and Bellevue Way NE
NE 16th Street, between 108th Avenue NE and 106th Avenue NE
106th Avenue NE, between NE 14th Street and NE 16th Street


Section 3. Parking of vehicles on the streets within Zone 4 is restricted to "No Parking 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Except Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays, Except by Zone 4 Permit".

Section 4. The parking restriction established by this ordinance shall be filed with and maintained by the City Clerk in accordance with Section 11.223.010 of the Bellevue City Code.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after passage by the City Council and legal publication.
