ORDINANCE NO. 5843

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of two grant agreements with the U.S. Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services for a total of \$1,758,364 (a grant of \$355,414 and a grant of \$1,402,950) on behalf of NORCOM for its technology equipment and consulting services; creating two projects within the Operating Grants and Donations Fund; appropriating unanticipated and future revenues to those funds; and authorizing expenditures of said grant funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a grant agreement with the U.S. Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services of up to \$355,414 on behalf of NORCOM for its needed consulting services, a copy of which grant agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 43466.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a grant agreement with the U.S. Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services of up to \$1,402,950 on behalf of NORCOM for its needed technology equipment and consulting services, a copy of which grant agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 43467.

Section 3. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant agreements.

Section 4. At the time of execution of said grant agreements and acceptances of said funds, two separate projects (one for each grant) shall be established within the Operating Grants and Donations Fund into which all said respective grant monies shall be deposited.

Section 5. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof including purchase agreements to expend funds as provided in said grant agreements.

Section 6. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the grant proposals and acceptances are:

Section 7. Upon execution of said grant agreements the budget for the Operating Grants and Donations Fund shall be amended by appropriating revenues in the amount of the grants and acceptances herein authorized.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified in said Grant Awards should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.


