

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5854

AN ORDINANCE related to Residential Permit Parking repealing Ordinance No. 4507, and creating a new Residential Permit Parking Zone 8 restricting parking on both sides of 110<sup>th</sup> Place SE, south of Main Street to "No Parking 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. Except Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays, Except by Zone 8 Permit".

WHEREAS, Policy TR-119 of the Transportation Element of the Comprehensive Plan states that the City will minimize spillover parking from commercial areas, parks, and other facilities encroaching on residential neighborhoods through residential parking zones: and

WHEREAS, over the past 15 years the City has been working with residents living on 110<sup>th</sup> Place SE to address spillover parking of vehicles from adjacent downtown businesses; and

WHEREAS, Council adopted Ordinance 4507 to address the residential parking issue; and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure uniform enforcement of the zone restrictions and conserve Police resources, Zone 8 restrictions will be changed; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance 4507 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. A new Residential Permit Parking Zone 8 is hereby created for both sides of 110<sup>th</sup> Place SE, south of Main Street.


Section 3. Parking of vehicles on the street within Zone 8 is restricted to "No Parking 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. Except Saturday, Sunday, and Holiday, Except by Zone 8 Permit. "

Section 4. The parking restrictions established by this ordinance shall be filed with and maintained by the City Clerk in accordance with Section 11.23.010 of the Bellevue City Code.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after passage by the City Council.




