

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5873

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to accept \$385,000 in federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funding; amending the 2009-2010 General CIP fund to increase by \$385,000; and, amending the 2009-2015 General CIP Plan (PW-W/B-77 Downtown Mid-Block Crossings) to increase the project budget by \$385,000.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a Grant Agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to accept \$385,000 in federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funding.

Section 2. The 2009-2010 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund appropriation adopted by Ordinance No. 5851 on December 1, 2008 as previously amended is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said CIP fund by \$385,000

Section 3. The City's 2009-2015 Capital Investment Program Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 5851 on December 1, 2008 as previously amended is hereby further amended by increasing the project budget (CIP Plan No.: PW-W/B-77-Downtown Mid-Block Crossings) by \$385,000.

Section 4. If the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified in said grant agreement shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations to the CIP Fund and Plan shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 5. The City Manager or his designee shall have the responsibility for the administration and expenditure of said grant monies and monies received pursuant to said Agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.


