ORDINANCE NO. 5881

AN ORDINANCE 1) adopting recommendations for the use of Community Development Block Grant-Recovery (CDBG-R) funds as transmitted by the Human Services Commission; 2) authorizing submission of a substantial amendment to the City of Bellevue's 2008 Action Plan to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the CDBG-R Program; 3) authorizing acceptance of a grant award contract with HUD for the CDBG-R Program in an amount not to exceed \$191,689; 4) establishing a new project within the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserve Fund; 5) authorizing the City Manager or his designee to enter into agreements with grant subrecipients, and 6) appropriating unanticipated and future revenues to that fund.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The recommendations from the Bellevue Human Services Commission for the use of Community Development Block Grant – Recovery (CDBG-R) funds, as set forth in the document given Clerk's Receiving No. 45118, and the recommended contingency plan, as set forth in the document given Clerk's Receiving No. 45119, are hereby adopted.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to submit a substantial amendment to the City of Bellevue's 2008 Action Plan to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the CDBG-R Program.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to accept a grant award contract with HUD for the CDBG-R Program in an amount not to exceed \$191,689.

Section 4. There shall be established at the time of execution and acceptance of said grant award contract, a project series within the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserve Fund for CDBG-R funds, into which all of said monies shall be deposited.

Section 5. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant award contract.

Section 6. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements with grant subrecipients to implement CDBG-eligible projects and programs in the amounts authorized by the City Council in Section 1.

Section 7. The estimated amount and anticipated source of revenue for the CDBG-R grant proposal and acceptance is:

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Section 8. Upon execution and acceptance of said grant award contract, the budget for the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserve Fund shall be amended by appropriating revenues in the amount of the grant and acceptance herein authorized:


Provided however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said grant contract should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 9. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 10. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.


