ORDINANCE NO. 5900

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of an Interagency Agreement (and any necessary supplements) with the Seattle Police Department of up to \$96,935 for the Bureau of Justice Assistance FY09 Recovery Act: Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program Local Solicitation (ARRA); amending the 2009-2010 budget of the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund in the amount of \$96,935; and authorizing expenditures from said fund.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an agreement with the Seattle Police Department of up to \$96,935 for the Bureau of Justice Assistance FY09 Recovery Act: Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program Local Solicitation (ARRA), a copy of which Interagency Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 45291.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Interagency Agreement.

Section 3. At the time of execution of said Interagency Agreement and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund into which all said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance is:

Section 6. Upon execution of said Interagency Agreement the budget for the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund shall be amended by appropriating revenue in the amount of the grant and acceptance herein authorized.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said Interagency Agreement should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.


