## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

### ORDINANCE NO. 5902

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of 1) amendment of the 2009-2010 General CIP fund to increase the appropriation by \$366,095 to reflect receipt of a developer contribution; and 2) amendment of the 2009-2015 CIP Plan to increase the project budget for the Signal Warrant/Safety Program (CIP Plan No. PW-I-84) by \$366,095.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee in hereby authorized to execute 1) amendment of the 2009-2010 General CIP Fund to increase the appropriation by \$366,095 to reflect receipt of a developer contribution; and 2) amendment of the 2009-2015 CIP Plan to increase the project budget for the Signal Warrant/Safety Program (CIP Plan No. PW-I-84) by \$366,095.

Section 2. The 2009-2010 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund appropriation adopted by Ordinance 5851 on December 1, 2008 as previously amended is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said CIP fund by \$366,095.

Section 3. The City's 2009-2010 General Capital Investment Program Plan adopted by Ordinance 5851 on December 1, 2009 as previously amended in hereby further amended by increasing the appropriation to said CIP fund and to increase the PW-I-84 project budget by \$366,095.


Section 4. If the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified in said grant amendment shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations to the CIP Fund and Plan shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received,.

Section 5. The City Manager or his designee shall have the responsibility for the administration and expenditure of said grant monies and monies received pursuant to said Amendment and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.
