

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5924

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of a Phase II Stormwater Pass-through Grant Agreement (and any subsequent grant-related documents) with the Washington State Department of Ecology to accept state grant funds of \$50,000 to support City-wide implementation of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Phase II Municipal Stormwater Permit; establishing a project within the Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund; appropriating unanticipated and future revenues to that fund; and authorizing the expenditure of said grant funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a Phase II Stormwater Pass-through Grant Agreement (and any subsequent grant-related documents) with the Washington State Department of Ecology to accept state grant funds of \$50,000 to support City-wide implementation of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Phase II Municipal Stormwater Permit; establishing a project within the Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund; appropriating unanticipated and future revenues to that fund; and authorizing the expenditure of said grant funds, a copy of which Agreement is given Clerk's Receiving No. 46706

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Phase II Stormwater Pass-through Grant Agreement.

Section 3. At the time of execution of said Phase II Stormwater Pass-through Grant Agreement, a project shall be established within the Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund into which all said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance is:

Section 6. Upon execution of said Phase II Stormwater Pass-through Grant Agreement, the budget for the Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund shall be amended by appropriating revenues in the amount of the grant and acceptance herein authorized.



Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified, in said Phase II Stormwater Pass-through Grant Agreement should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.


