

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5930

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City Manager or his designee to: 1) execute an interlocal agreement (and supplements, if necessary) with King County Metro (KCM), in the total amount of \$612,500, (including the acceptance of \$472,500 in pass-through grant funds from KCM) for the Connect Downtown Implementation Project 2010-2011; 2) execute an agreement (and supplements, if necessary) with the Bellevue Downtown Association (BDA), in an amount not to exceed \$382,825, for implementation services associated with the Connect Downtown Implementation Project 2010-2011; 3) amend the 2009-2010 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) fund to increase the appropriation by \$472,500; and 4) amend of the 2009-2015 Bellevue CIP fund by increasing the project budget for Transportation Demand Management (CIP Plan No. PW-R-87) by \$472,500 in new pass-through funding contributions from King County Metro.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an interlocal agreement (and supplements, if necessary) with King County Metro, in the total amount of \$612,500, (including the acceptance of \$472,500 in pass-through grant funds from KCM) for the Connect Downtown Implementation Project 2010-2011, a copy of which agreement in substantial form has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 45883

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an agreement with the Bellevue Downtown Association (and supplements, if necessary), in an amount not to exceed \$382,825, for implementation services associated with the Connect Downtown Implementation Project 2010-2011, a copy of which agreement in substantial form has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 45782

Section 3. The City's 2009-2010 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund appropriation adopted by Ordinance No. 5851 on December 1, 2008, as may have been previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said fund by \$472,500 to recognize the funding from the following:

Federal CMAQ Funds (through KCM)	\$337,500
State I-405 Construction Mitigation funds (through KCM)	<u>135,000</u>
Total from Anticipated Sources	<u>\$472,500</u>

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth in herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 4. The City's 2009-2015 General CIP Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 5851 on December 1, 2008, as may have been previously amended, is hereby further amended by increasing the project budget for Transportation Demand Management (CIP Plan No. PW-R-87) by \$472,500 in new pass-through funding contributions from King County Metro to reflect these additional funds.

Section 5. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration and expenditure of said funds and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.


