ORDINANCE NO. 5940

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of an interlocal agreement for the 2010-2011 Waste Reduction and Recycling (WRR) Grant Program with King County to accept grant reimbursement funds of \$364,997 to implement waste reduction and recycling education programs in accordance with the King County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan; establishing a project within the Operating Grants and Donations Fund; appropriating unanticipated and future revenues to that fund; and authorizing expenditures of said funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an interlocal agreement with the King County Solid Waste Division of up to \$364,997 to implement hazardous waste prevention and education programs in accordance with the Local Hazardous Waste Management Plan (LHWHP), a copy of which interlocal agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 46446.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said interlocal agreement.

Section 3. At the time of execution of said interlocal agreement and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established with the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund into which all said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designee shall have the responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance is:

Section 6. Upon execution of said Amendment No. 1 to the interlocal agreement the budget for the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund shall be amended by appropriating revenue in the amount of the grant and acceptance herein authorized.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said to interlocal agreement should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.




