ORDINANCE NO. 5941

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of an interlocal agreement with the Washington State Department of Ecology to accept \$79,446 in reimbursement grant funds from the Coordinated Prevention Grant Program (CPG) for implementing recycling and hazardous waste prevention and education programs; establishing a project within the Operating Grants and Donations Fund; amending the budget for the Operating Grants and Donations fund by appropriating additional revenues to those funds; authorizing expenditures of grant monies and said funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement with the State of Washington, Department of Ecology to accept grant funds from the Coordinated Prevention Grant Program (CPG) to fund recycling and hazardous waste prevention and education programs, a copy of which Interlocal Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 46160.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Interlocal Agreement.

Section 3. At the time of execution of said Interlocal Agreement and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within the Operating Grants and Donations Fund into which all said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. The approximate amount and source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance are:

Section 6. Upon execution of said Interlocal Agreement, the budget for the Operating Grants and Donations fund shall be amended by appropriating to those funds additional revenues in the amount of the grant proposal and acceptance herein authorized.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said grant agreement should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.




