ORDINANCE NO. 5945

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of Contract For Services # 201000027 (and amendments if necessary) with the Puget Sound Clean Air Agency, to accept reimbursement grant funds up to \$212,000, for the purchase of alternative fuel and advanced technology vehicles; amending the 2010-2011 budget of the Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund in an amount up to \$212,000; and authorizing expenditures from said fund.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute Contract For Services # 201000027 (and amendments if necessary) with the Puget Sound Clean Air Agency, to accept reimbursement grant funds up to \$212,000, for the purchase of alternative fuel and advanced technology vehicles, a copy of which Contract for Services has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 45951.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Contract for Services.

Section 3. At the time of execution of said Contract for Services and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund into which all said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance is:

Section 6. Upon execution of said Contract for Services, the budget for the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund shall be amended by appropriating revenue in the amount of the grant and acceptance herein authorized.

Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund	up to \$212,000

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said Contract for Services should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.


