

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5960

AN ORDINANCE authorizing; 1) execution of a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT), to accept a federal Transportation, Community, and System Preservation Program grant, in the amount of \$360,000, to advance implementation of the SCATS traffic adaptive signal control system along key corridors in downtown Bellevue and the Hospital District; 2) amendment of the 2009-2010 General CIP fund to increase by \$360,000; and, 3) amendment of the 2009-2015 Capital Investment Program (CIP Plan No. PW-R-155) by \$360,000.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a Grant Agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT), to accept a federal Transportation, Community, and System Preservation Program grant, in the amount of \$360,000, to advance implementation of the SCATS traffic adaptive signal control system along key corridors in downtown Bellevue and the Hospital District.

Section 2. The 2009-2010 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund appropriation adopted by Ordinance No. 5851 on December 1, 2008, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said CIP fund by \$360,000.

Section 3. The City's 2009-2015 Capital Investment Program Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 5851 on December 1, 2008, as previously amended, is hereby further amended by increasing the project budget (CIP Plan No. PW-R-155 ) by \$360,000.

Section 4. If the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified in said grant agreement shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations to the CIP Fund and Plan shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.


Section 5. The City Manager or his designee shall have the responsibility for the administration and expenditure of said grant monies and monies received pursuant to said Agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.


