

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6030

AN ORDINANCE relating to the mid-biennial review and modification of the 2011-2012 biennial budget as required by RCW 35A.34.130 and Ordinance No. 4872; adopting certain modifications to the 2011-2012 biennial budget; and establishing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 4872 on April 15, 1996 adopting a fiscal biennium budget beginning in 1997, as authorized by chapter 35A.34 RCW, and providing for mid-biennial review and modification as required by RCW 35A.34.130; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 5978 on December 6, 2010 adopting a fiscal biennium budget for 2011-2012; and

WHEREAS, as required by Section 2 of Ordinance No. 4872, the City Manager has submitted to the City Council a proposed mid-biennial budget modification; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the proposed mid-biennial budget modification was held before the City Council on November 28, 2011 pursuant to proper notice to the public; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the proposed mid-biennial budget modification and has considered any and all comments received from the public at the public hearing and by written comment with regard to such proposed mid-biennial budget modification; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to adopt the 2011-2012 mid-biennial budget modification; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The mid-biennial budget modification to the biennium budget of the City of Bellevue, Washington, for the years 2011-2012, a copy of which modification has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 48651, is hereby adopted.

Section 2. The estimated revenues and appropriations for the following funds are adjusted by increasing the appropriation by the amounts shown below:

Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund	\$1,000,000
Franchise Fund	<u>200,000</u>
Total 2011-2012 Mid-Biennium Update Appropriation Adjustment	\$1,200,000

Section 3. The 2011 pay plans previously adopted shall remain in effect until amended.

Section 4. All employees who are members of a bargaining unit shall receive such pay and benefits as are provided for in the appropriate collective bargaining agreement.

Section 5. The Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Office of the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations and to the Association of Washington Cities.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.


