

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6031

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of a Grant Agreement (and any necessary supplements) with the Transportation Improvement Board, to accept a state-funded \$124,465 Urban Sidewalk Program grant for installation of a missing sidewalk segment fronting 11839 NE 8th Street; 2) amending the 2011-2012 general Capital Investment Program (CIP) to increase appropriation by \$124,465; and 3) amending the 2011-2017 CIP Plan to increase the budget for the Pedestrian Access Improvements Program (CIP Plan No. PW-W/B-56) by \$124,465 and authorize expenditures from said fund.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an Agreement (and any necessary supplements) with the Transportation Improvement Board to accept a state-funded Urban Sidewalk Program grant in the amount of \$124,465, for installation of a missing sidewalk segment fronting 11839 NE 8th Street, a copy of which Grant Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 50263.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to amend the 2011-2012 general Capital Investment Program (CIP) to increase the appropriation by \$124,465.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to amend the 2011-2017 CIP Plan to increase the budget for the Pedestrian Access Improvements Program (CIP Plan No. PW-W/B-56) by \$124,465 and authorize expenditures from said fund.

Section 4. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Agreement.

Section 5. The City Manager or his designee shall have the responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 6. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the Agreement are:

Section 7. Upon execution of said Grant Agreement, the budget for the 2011-2017 CIP Plan shall be amended by appropriating revenues in the amount of the grant and acceptance herein authorized.

Pedestrian Access Improvements Program	\$124,465

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said Interlocal Agreement should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.
