ORDINANCE NO. 6043

AN ORDINANCE repealing Ordinance No. 5179, which established Residential Permit Parking Zone 12 in the Dogwood Neighborhood, restricting parking to "No Parking 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Daily, Except by Zone 12 Permit" on both sides of the 1800 blocks of 114<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE and 115<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE, 11400 and 11500 blocks of NE 18<sup>th</sup> Street, 11400 and 11500 blocks of NE 20<sup>th</sup> Street, 11400 and 11500 blocks of NE 21<sup>st</sup> Street.

WHEREAS, Policy TR-119 of the Transportation Element of the Comprehensive Plan states that the City will minimize spillover parking from commercial areas, parks, and other facilities encroaching on residential neighborhoods through residential parking zones: and

WHEREAS, since the establishment of Ordinance 5179 in November 1999 which addressed residential parking issues in the Dogwood Neighborhood, almost all of the properties in Zone 12 have been converted to businesses so Residential Parking Permit Zone 12 is no longer needed; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Ordinance 5179 is hereby repealed.


