ORDINANCE NO. 6050

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of an interlocal agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the City of Redmond to accept interlocal contributions of \$300,000 to fund costs associated with a joint pavement overlay project on 148th Avenue NE and 156th Avenue NE in the Overlake area; 2) amending the 2011-2012 general Capital Investment Program (CIP) fund to increase the appropriation by \$300,000; and; 3) amending the 2011-2017 CIP Plan to increase the budget for the Overlay Program (CIP Plan No. PW-M-1) by \$300,000 and authorizing expenditures from said fund.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an interlocal agreement (and any necessary supplements) with the City of Redmond to accept interlocal contributions of \$300,000 to fund costs associated with a joint pavement overlay project on 148th Avenue NE and 156th Avenue NE in the Overlake area, which interlocal agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. 48740.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said interlocal agreements.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee is hereby further authorized to execute all documents necessary to fulfill the terms of the agreements authorized in Section 1 and 2.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designee shall have the responsibility for the administration and expenditure of said monies and monies received pursuant to said Agreements and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. The 2011-2012 General (CIP) Fund appropriation adopted by Ordinance No. 5978 on December 6, 2010 as previously amended is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said CIP fund by \$300,000.

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Section 6. The City's 2011-2017 General CIP Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 5978 on December 6, 2010 as previously amended is hereby further amending by increasing the project budget for the joint pavement overlay project (CIP Plan No. PW-M-1) by \$300,000.

Section 7. If the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified in said interlocal agreements shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations to the CIP Fund and Plan shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.


