

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6073

AN ORDINANCE related to Residential Permit Parking repealing Ordinance No. 3994, and creating a new Residential Permit Parking Zone 5, restricting parking on the 1000 block of NE 13th and NE 15th Streets and the 1300, 1400 and 1500 blocks of 102nd Avenue NE to "No Parking 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Except Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays, Except by Zone 5 Permit".

WHEREAS, Policy TR-119 of the Transportation Element of the Comprehensive Plan states that the City will minimize spillover parking from commercial areas, parks, and other facilities encroaching on residential neighborhoods through residential parking zones: and

WHEREAS, over the years the City has been working with residents living in the Manor Hill Neighborhood to address spillover parking of vehicles from adjacent downtown businesses; and

WHEREAS, Council adopted Ordinance 3994 in 1989 to address the residential parking issues in this area; and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure uniform enforcement of the zone restrictions and to conserve Police resources, Zone 5 restrictions need to be changed; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance 3994 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. A new Residential Permit Parking Zone 5 is hereby created for the 1000 block of NE 13th and NE 15th Streets and the 1300, 1400, and 1500 blocks of 102nd Avenue.

Section 3. Parking of vehicles on the street within Zone 5 is restricted to "No Parking 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Except Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays, Except by Zone 5 Permit. "

Section 4. The parking restrictions established by this ordinance shall be filed with and maintained by the City Clerk in accordance with Section 11.23.010 of the Bellevue City Code.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after passage by the City Council.
