

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6117

AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance 5811, subsequently amended by Ordinance No. 5938, extending the existing boundaries of Residential Permit Parking Zone 3 to include the east side of 107th Avenue SE from SE 10th Street, north to the end of the cul-de-sac and both sides of SE 10th Street from 107th Avenue SE to 108th Avenue SE.

WHEREAS, Policy TR-110 of the Transportation Element of the Comprehensive Plan states that the City will minimize spillover parking from commercial areas, parks, and other facilities encroaching on residential neighborhoods through residential parking zones, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 5811 was passed and subsequently amended by Ordinance 5938, in response to residential parking issues near high schools, in Bellevue; and

WHEREAS, since the passing of Ordinance 5938, spillover parking has relocated east of the school; and

WHEREAS, due to concerns from residents living just south of Bellevue High School, the zone spillover parking zone needs to be expanded again; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance 5811, as previously amended by Ordinance 5938, is hereby further amended to add the following:

A new Residential Permit Parking Zone 3 is hereby created to include the east side of 107th Avenue SE from SE 10th Street north to the end of the cul-de-sac and both sides of SE 10th Street from 107th Avenue SE to 108th Avenue SE.


Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after passage by the City Council.


