## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

### ORDINANCE NO. 6123

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of an Interlocal Agreement with the City of North Bend and King County Fire District No. 38 to provide quarters for Bellevue Medic Three; amending the 2013-2014 General Fund Budget to increase the appropriation by \$250,000; and authorizing expenditures of said grant funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement between the City of North Bend and King County Fire District No. 38 to pay North Bend the \$250,000 in additional intergovernmental revenue received from King County Emergency Medical Services (EMS) to provide quarters for Bellevue Medic Three, a copy of which Interlocal Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 50626

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Agreement.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration and expenditure of said funds and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the Interlocal Agreement are:

King County Emergency Medical Services	\$250,000

Section 5. Upon execution of said Interlocal Agreement, the budget for the 2013-2014 General Fund shall be amended by appropriating revenues in the fund and acceptance herein authorized.


<u>Description</u>	<u>Amount Appropriated</u>
2013-2014 General Fund	\$250,000

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said Interlocal Agreement should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.


