ORDINANCE NO. 6126

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of an amended Interlocal Agreement (ILA) with the Bellevue School District (BSD) for the assignment of a maximum of six School Resource Officers (SRO) to be stationed at Bellevue high and middle schools during the 2013-2014 school year; amending the 2013-2014 General Fund revenue budget by \$167,787; and adding an officer FTE to the police department authorized Patrol position total as backfill for the SRO.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an amendment to the Agreement with Bellevue School District for the assignment of a maximum of six School Resource Officers (SRO) for the 2013-2014 school year, a copy of this amended Interlocal Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 50542.

Section 2. The approximate amounts to be added to the 2013-2014 General Fund and source of revenue are:

Bellevue School District (2013)	\$65,417
Bellevue School District (2014)	\$102,370

Section 3. Upon execution of said Amended Interlocal Agreement, the 2013-2014 General Fund budget and appropriation, adopted pursuant to Ordinance 6089 on December 3, 2012 as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the budget and appropriation to said Fund by \$167,787 to reflect additional revenues in the amount of the funding and acceptance herein authorized.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said Agreement should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the budget and appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.


