

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6130

AN ORDINANCE authorizing (1) the execution of an Interlocal Agreement with the cities of Kirkland, Mercer Island, Redmond, and King County Fire Protection District No. 16 (also known as Northshore Fire Department) for purposes of conducting joint training and fire recruit academies as the "East Metro Training Group" (EMTG); (2) the creation of a new Special Revenue Fund for the EMTG; (3) appropriation of unanticipated revenue to the EMTG fund for 2014; and (4) expenditures of said revenue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement with the cities of Kirkland, Mercer Island, Redmond, and King County Fire Protection District No. 16 (also known as Northshore Fire Department) for purposes of conducting joint training and fire recruit academies as the "East Metro Training Group" (EMTG), a copy of which Interlocal Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 50978.

Section 2. There is hereby created a new Special Revenue Fund for the EMTG.

Section 3. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to amend the budget as necessary to create and administer the new Special Revenue Fund for the EMTG.

Section 4. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive, deposit, and appropriate monies into the new EMTG Special Revenue Fund as authorized in the Interlocal Agreement, including unanticipated revenue for the EMTG for 2014.


Section 5. The appropriate administrative officials of the City shall have responsibility for the administration of said revenue and are hereby authorized to expend said monies as authorized in the Interlocal Agreement.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.
