ORDINANCE NO. 6165

AN ORDINANCE authorizing: 1) execution of a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT), to accept a federal funded Transportation Alternatives grant in the amount of \$470,000 in order to complete the design of the at-grade segments of the Mountains-to-Sound Greenway Trail between Factoria Boulevard and 150<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE; 2) amending the 2013-2014 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) fund to increase the appropriation by \$470,000; and; 3) amending the 2013-2019 Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan to increase the budget and modify the description and scope for the Mountains-to-Sound Greenway Project (CIP Plan No. PW-W/B-78) by \$470,000 and authorizing expenditures from said fund.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to accept a federal funded Transportation Alternatives grant in the amount of \$470,000 in order to complete the design of the at-grade segments of the Mountains-to-Sounds Greenway between Factoria Boulevard and 150<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE, which grant agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. 51701.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is hereby further authorized to execute all documents necessary to fulfill the terms of the agreements authorized in Section 1.

Section 3. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant agreements.

Section 4. The 2013-2014 General (CIP) Fund appropriation adopted by Ordinance No. 6089 on December 3, 2012, as previously amended, is hereby amended to increase the appropriation to said CIP fund by \$470,000.

Section 5. The City's 2013-2019 General CIP Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 6089 on December 3, 2012, as previously amended, is hereby further amended by increasing the project budget and modifying the description and scope for the Mountains-to-Sound Greenway Project (CIP Plan No. PW-W/B-78) by \$470,000.



Section 6. If the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified in said grant agreements shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations to the CIP Fund and Plan shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.




