ORDINANCE NO. 6178

AN ORDINANCE authorizing an increase to the construction contract (Bid No. 13001) with Johansen Excavating, Inc. for the 120th Avenue NE (Stage 1) – NE 4th to NE 8th Street Improvement Project, (CIP Plan No. PW-R-161) by \$599,031; 2) Amending the 2013-2019 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan to increase the budget by \$540,075 by recognizing \$261,396 in New Franchise Utility Contribution revenue and a budget transfer of \$278,679 from the Overlay Program (CIP Plan No. PW-M-1; and 3) Amending the 2013-2014 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund to increase the appropriation by \$261,396.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to increase to the construction contract with Johansen Excavating, Inc., (Bid No. 13001) by \$599,031 for a total contract amount of \$4,462,460 to complete the 120th Avenue NE (Stage 1) – NE 4th to NE 8th Street Improvement Project (CIP Plan No. PW-R-161), which agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. 51738.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is hereby further authorized to make a budget transfer of \$278,679 from the Overlay Program (CIP Plan No. PW-M-1).

Section 3. The City's 2013-2019 Capital Investment Program Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 6089 on December 3, 2012, is hereby amended to increase the project budget for the 120th Avenue NE (Stage 1) project (CIP Plan No. PW-R-161) by \$540,075.

Section 4. The 2013-2014 Capital Investment Program Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 6089 on December 3, 2012, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said CIP fund by \$261,396, to recognize new Franchise Utility Contribution revenue.

Section 5. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 6. If the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified in said agreements shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set

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forth herein, the amount budgeted to the plan shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.


