

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 6502

A RESOLUTION authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute, on behalf of the City, a Relinquishment of Sewer Easement to relinquish certain sanitary sewer rights no longer required by the City.

WHEREAS, an easement in favor of the Bellevue Sewer District, to which the City is successor in interest, for sanitary sewer pipeline purposes was executed in April, 1953 with regard to property at 604 Bellevue Way NE, Bellevue, Washington, and recorded under King County Recording No. 4476669; and

WHEREAS, the sanitary sewer pipeline located in this easement has been relocated and this easement is no longer needed by the Bellevue Utilities Department; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute, on behalf of the City, that certain Relinquishment of Sewer Easement, a copy of which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 29693.
