RESOLUTION NO. 6512

A RESOLUTION adopting the City of Bellevue Federal Legislative Agenda for the 2001 Congressional session.

WHEREAS, the purpose of the city government is to provide the highest level of service to its citizens in the most efficient and effective manner possible; and

WHEREAS, cities in Washington are subject to federal legislative action; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue believes that local government can be the most effective level of government if given the opportunity and should be given the authority to make decisions which are primarily local in nature; and

WHEREAS, the Bellevue City Council wishes to communicate its legislative priorities to members of the Washington State Congressional delegation; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Favorable consideration by the Congress of the United States of the issues identified in the Federal Legislative Agenda for 2001, a copy of which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 29921, will enable the City to more effectively service its residents. Therefore, the Federal Legislative Agenda for 2001 is hereby adopted.

Section 2. The Federal Legislative Agenda for 2001 shall be conveyed to the Washington State Congressional delegation and shall form the basis for City of Bellevue communications with delegation members during the 2001 congressional session.
