RESOLUTION NO. 6513

A RESOLUTION RESOLUTION authorizing the City Council to adopt the Master Plan Alternative 1A, as well as adopting "Sixth Street Park" as the official park name for the new mini park located at 10150 SE 6th Street.

WHEREAS, one of the goals of the Parks Open Space and Recreation Element of the Comprehensive Plan is to develop, operate and maintain parkland and cultural and recreation facilities in a manner that is responsive to the site and the needs of the community;

WHEREAS, Policy PA-1 of the Comprehensive Plan is to establish a coordinated and connected system of open space and greenways throughout the City that provide multiple benefits including preserving natural systems, protecting wildlife habitat and corridors as well as provide land for recreation;

WHEREAS, Policy PA-4 of the Comprehensive Plan is to equitably distribute neighborhood park and recreation opportunities by type throughout the City;

WHEREAS, Policy S-SB-1 of the Comprehensive Plan is to recognize existing land use patterns and densities while providing for the maintenance of services, public facilities and utilities appropriate to serve the area;

WHEREAS, Subarea Policy S-SB-7 of the Comprehensive Plan is to provide for the physical separation of differing land uses utilizing natural barriers including steep slope unstable soils, wetlands, waterways, or landscaping including landscaped terms;

WHEREAS, the Bellevue Parks and Open Space System Plan recommends the development of mini-parks throughout the City;

WHEREAS, the development of neighborhood facilities was identified as one of the community's top priority for park facilities;

WHEREAS, the Bellevue Parks and Open Space System Plan identifies a deficit of min-parks in the South Bellevue Subarea;

WHEREAS, the Bellevue Parks and Open Space System Plan recommends acquiring and developing mini parks in this South Bellevue Subarea;

WHEREAS, the Master Plan Alternative 1A meets both the priorities set forth in the Bellevue Parks and Open Space System Plan and the Comprehensive Plan Policies PA-1, PA-4, S-SB-1 and S-SB-7; and

WHEREAS, "Sixth Street Park" meets both the priorities as set forth in the Bellevue Parks and Open Space Systems Plan and the criteria set by Resolution 4803 which established policies ad procedures relating to the naming of public parks and parks and recreation facilities; and
