

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 6605

A RESOLUTION concerning LID 277 and approving the application for a segregation of assessments on certain property located in the block bordered by NE 8th Street to the north, NE 6th Street to the south, 108th Avenue NE to the west and 110th Avenue NE to the east, within the City of Bellevue.

WHEREAS, on October 2, 1989, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 4023 confirming the assessment roll for LID 277, including the property hereinafter requested to be segregated; and

WHEREAS, the property owners have requested a segregation of the assessments on the property hereinafter described, as the result of a boundary line adjustment, No. BLA-00-264540; and

WHEREAS, as segregated the property would be assessed as nearly as possible on the same basis as the original assessment was levied and the security of the liens for such assessments will not be jeopardized so as to reduce the security for any outstanding local improvement district obligations payable for such assessments; and

WHEREAS, the total of the segregated parts of the assessment roll shall be equal to the assessment before segregation; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer and City Treasurer, in writing, have approved the application of the property owners for a segregation of assessment; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby approves the request of the property owners for a segregation of the assessment on the following described property:

Assessment 277-0386-000

This property was originally assessed in the amount of \$19,858.21 by LID No. 277.

Assessment 277-0387-000

This property was originally assessed in the amount of \$23,111.51 by LID No. 277.

Assessment 277-0388-000

This property was originally assessed in the amount of \$13,088.37 by LID No. 277.

Assessment 277-0389-000

This property was originally assessed in the amount of \$11,025.89 by LID No. 277.

Assessment 277-0390-000

This property was originally assessed in the amount of \$6,028.48 by LID No. 277.

Assessment 277-0392-000

This property was originally assessed in the amount of \$5,576.61 by LID No. 277.

Assessment 277-0393-000

This property was originally assessed in the amount of \$5,593.95 by LID No. 277.

Section 2. The original boundaries of the parcels are attached as Exhibit A and the revised boundaries of the parcels are attached hereto as Exhibit B; the amounts to be assessed against the segregated parts shall be as follows:

Assessment No. 277-0386-101

On which the assessment under LID No. 277 shall be \$10,102.27.

Assessment No. 277-0387-101

On which the assessment under LID No. 277 shall be \$18,645.59.

Assessment No. 277-0388-101

On which the assessment under LID No. 277 shall be \$55,455.16.

Section 3. The City Council finds that by such segregation the security of the liens for such assessments will not be jeopardized so as to reduce the security for any outstanding local improvement district obligations payable from such assessments.

Section 4. The City Treasurer is hereby ordered to make such segregation on the original assessment rolls as provided herein.
