RESOLUTION NO. 6663

A RESOLUTION authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute Agreements for Public Defense Services for 2002 and 2003 with Tucker & Stein, P.S., Inc. and The Amini Law Firm, P.S., to provide indigent defense services for persons accused of criminal violations of Bellevue City ordinances, in the base amounts, respectively, of \$198,600 and \$108,000 per year, plus additional fees for cases in excess of annual minimums, appeals and reimbursement of costs and expenses.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute those certain Agreements for Public Defense Services with Tucker & Stein, P.S., Inc. and The Amini Law Firm, P.S., to provide indigent defense services during 2002 and 2003 for persons accused of criminal violations of Bellevue City ordinances, in the base amounts, respectively, of \$198,600 and \$108,000 per year, plus additional fees for cases in excess of annual minimums, appeals, and reimbursement of costs and expenses, copies of which Agreements have been given Clerk's Receiving Nos. 31771 and 31759, respectively.
