

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 6746

A RESOLUTION authorizing the City Manager to execute on behalf of the City, a Relinquishment of Sewer Easement to relinquish sanitary sewer pipeline rights no longer required by the City.

WHEREAS, in April 1954, the Bellevue Sewer District, now the Bellevue Sewer Department, acquired at no cost an easement for a sanitary sewer pipeline across property located at 139 106th Avenue NE, Bellevue, Washington and recorded under King County Recording No. 4476742; and

WHEREAS, in October 1960, the sanitary sewer pipeline was relocated and a new easement was granted; and

WHEREAS, no sewer pipeline was ever installed in the original easement and the easement is no longer required by the Bellevue Utilities Department, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute on behalf of the City, that Certain Relinquishment of Sewer Easement, a copy of which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 32846.
